Terms & Conditions For Sale of Goods and Services From SMP Bearings Ltd.



Definitions:

Unless the context otherwise requires, the following definitions shall apply to these terms and conditions:-

“Company” – SMP Bearings Ltd.

“Buyer” – the purchaser of the goods from the Company shown on the front of this form.

“Goods” – means goods and services supplied by the Company to the buyer.

1. For charge accounts, terms of payment are on or before the 20th of the month following the invoice date. All overdue accounts may attract a monthly administration fee of 2%. In the event of debt recovery, all charges will be payable by the customer.
2. Any price agreed between the Company and the buyer at the date of the order may be varied, if wages, salaries, costs or materials, freight rates, taxes, insurance or duties unless otherwise agreed between the Company and the buyer.
3. Notification of shortages or discrepancy must be made within seven (7) days of dispatch / document.
4. Requests to return goods must be submitted within seven (7) days from the date of supply and original document / invoice number must be quoted.
5. Where goods are accepted (for credit or refund at the Company’s discretion) they must be delivered at the buyers expense into the Company’s store in the original condition and packaging. A 20% restocking fee will apply on credited goods.
6. The Company reserves the right to levy a handling fee against any returns; the Company may agree to accept
7. Indented and / or procured goods will not be returnable.
8. The goods will be supplied to the buyer on these terms and conditions unless the Company agrees in writing to change them.
9. The Company will not be bound by any conditions included in the buyer’s order unless it expressly accepts them in writing.
10. The Company retains full ownership of all goods sold by the Company, until full payment is received for all amounts owing in respect of all goods supplied.
11. Any claim against the Company is to be limited to the invoice value of the goods. Liability for all consequential damage is excluded.
12. The Company shall not be liable to the buyer for any loss or damage directly or indirectly arising out of or in connection with any delay in delivery of the goods or failure to perform any term of this contract where such failure of delay is caused directly or indirectly by an act of fire, armed conflict, labour dispute, civil commotion, intervention of a government, inability to obtain labour, materials or facilities and accidents, interruptions of, or delay in transportation beyond the Company’s control.
13. The contract shall be construed in accordance with and be governed by the laws of New Zealand and the New Zealand courts shall have jurisdiction over any dispute.
14. Under the Privacy Act, you authorise any person or company to provide us with such information, as we require in response to our credit enquiries. That you authorise us to furnish to any third party, details of this application and any subsequent dealings that you may have with us as a result of this application being accepted by us.
15. The price shall become immediately payable regardless of the terms of payment and the Company may take immediate action to recover the price if the buyer is in default under this agreement or commits an act of bankruptcy or goes into liquidation or receivership or enters into a creditors composition or has its credit standing impaired in any other way.
16. Placement of order and / or receipt of goods will be deemed to confirm your understanding and acceptance of these terms and conditions.
